

PENNINGTON COUNTY
CULVERT POLICY

Following is the Highway Department policy regarding the furnishing of culverts to individual land owners abutting on existing highways.

- *1. One culvert, as required, (up to 30 feet in length, added length to be paid by land owner) will be furnished for each parcel of land of 1/4 of a section (nominal 160 acres) or more in size. The culvert shall be picked up and installed by the property owner.
2. Additional field crossings will be allowed only on the approval of the County Engineer. Used culverts for these crossings may be obtained at 1/2 the current new culvert price, when available. Culverts to be picked up and installed by the property owner.
3. Individuals with parcels smaller than 160 acres can purchase used culverts at 1/2 the current price of new culverts, when available. Culverts to be picked up and installed by the property owner.
4. Culvert extensions (up to 30 feet total culvert length) for existing driveways and field entrances may be provided by the County. Pick-up and installation shall be by the property owner.
5. County Road Centerline culverts, under gravel roads, will be furnished and installed by the County. The cost of installation shall be split 50/50 with the benefiting property owner.
6. Pipe for replacement of existing entrance culverts will be furnished and installed by the County at the rate of one per land owner per quarter (nominal 160 acres).
7. No new crossings, or modification of existing facilities, will be made without the approval of the local Watershed District.
8. This policy does not apply to Judicial Ditches because approval needs to go through a Joint Board.
9. Any construction proposed which will contribute or modify works located on or within the County Right of Way shall obtain prior approval of the County Engineer's office. A survey may be required.

* Special exceptions may be considered in cases of extremely deep ditches and/or smaller parcels of land showing extreme need and/or high assessment value.
